

## WORKSHOPS: Useful Vocabulary (level A2-B2)

Topics	What you will learn
All about Cars	Features of cars and car maintenance, specialist terms to talk about hybrid cars and biocars, describe driving practices
Arts and Culture	Vocabulary for an art exhibition, terms to talk about the financing of art events, different kinds of art work and artists, and the problem of art forgeries and art theft
Computers and IT Equipment	Computer functions, computer problems, tasks performed on or with a computer
Describing Trends	Economic indicators, key collocations, changes in an economy, trends, stability, volatility
Emotional times	How to react to emotional situations, talk about positive and negative feelings at work, nouns, adjectives and adverbs to talk about emotions
Energy	Basic energy needs, renewable and non-renewable sources of energy, common collocations with "power"
Get Connected!	Talk about the devices and gadgets used to communicate, technology and telecommunications, jobs in telecommunications, idiomatic expressions to talk communicating by telephone, small talk about mobile phones, smartphones, and types of contracts
Hobbies	Talk about dinner parties, personal food preferences and cooking at home, popular hobbies and the people, make small talk on hobbies
Human Resources	Common tasks, typical work conditions, company benefits, pay, talk about HR topics and issues
Insurance	Talk about disasters and how you can protect yourself from unexpected costs, insurance policies, and how to make a claim, insurance fraud
International conferences	Talk about protests, describe police actions, describe different types of conferences, trade fairs and international summits, describe different kinds of venues and equipment, talk about the organizers, participants and speakers
Politics	Vocabulary for talking about what happens on the day of election, key people in government, language to talk about legislation and tax
Popular sports	Describe and exciting race, describe equipment for ball games, talk about the players, summer sporting events, football, victory and defeat
Property	Different ways to modernize property, describe commercial and residential property, financial and legal terms
Retailing	Talk about the retail business, stores, products and online platforms, retailing strategies and pricing, learn common shopping idioms for talking about business situations
Talking about Food	Items of a restaurant table, courses of a meal, various kinds of meat, fish, vegetables, international menu, describe how a dish is made, special diets
Talking about money	Talk about everyday money matters, banking terms, personal finances, financial statements, financial success and problems

Talking about production	Describe basic equipment and talk about industries, types of production facilities, stages of production, specialist terms used to describe problems and tasks during production
Talking about time	Objects to measure time, schedules, deadlines, appointments, making arrangements, talk about time periods, describe how to manage time
The language of innovation	Adjectives you can use to talk about innovative products, learn about different kinds of innovation and the innovation process, and talk about innovative workplaces and ideas
The language of law	Types of court and the people you see at trial, fields of law and the key people, trials, legal proceedings and sentencing, crime and honesty
The language of marketing	Market research, marketing areas, product, price, place and promotion, getting products on the market, brands, marketing measures, marketing campaigns and social media
The News Media	Live broadcasts, print and digital products, journalists and editors work, useful media expressions, and essential idioms
The world of fashion	Clothing, textile industry, specialist terms to describe how clothes are made and altered, dress codes
The world of music	Talk about musicians and equipment, musical instruments, notation and how music sounds, and language you need to talk about listening to music
You and your job	Talk about common professions, industries, job titles, use word partnerships with "job" and "work"
Your Company	The structure of the company, departments and divisions, hierarchical structures and responsibilities, various types of businesses and legal entities
Your health	Common injuries, titles of doctors and names of examinations, health problems and treatments, illnesses, pain
Your holidays	Different types of holiday accommodation, trips and activities, company's policy on holidays, small talk about experiences on holidays
Your office	Office location, layout, culture, equipment, people in the office, political offices, office tasks and duties
Your Qualities and Qualifications	Talk about school and university qualifications, training, personal qualities, job skills and education
